PROGRAMS

Kayak Tour: Search for birds, fish, manatees and dolphins as you paddle through the Estero Bay in a tandem kayak. Ages 12 and up. COST: \$45 per person (Members \$15) Museum Admission included. Register at moundhouse.org.

Family Fun Kayak Tour: Have fun with the whole family at the Mound House with a kayak tour designed specifically for families with children ages six and up. Must have children ages 6 to 11 years of age to register for this tour. COST: \$15 (ages 6 to 11) \$25 (ages 12 and up) Museum Admission included (Members \$10) Register at moundhouse.org.

Sunset Kayak Tour: Scheduled to catch a beautiful sunset, participants will explore tidal creeks and winding mangrove tunnels of Estero Bay as only a kayaker can. COST: \$45 per person, Museum Admission included (Members \$15). Register at moundhouse.org.

Full Moon Kayak Tour: This unique tour offers rare opportunity to experience the abundant life within our estuary in the quiet of twilight by the light of the full moon. COST: \$45 per person Museum Admission not included. (Members \$15) Register at moundhouse.org.

Beach Walk: Explore the natural treasures on Fort Myers Beach through a guided walk along the shore. Participants should meet at Newton Beach Park under the thatched hut (4650 Estero Blvd). COST: FREE.

Calusa Carvers: Learn more about woodcarving from a local group of woodcarvers who have made some of the replicas used in exhibits and programs. COST: FREE. Does not include admission.

Shell Mound Tour: Explore the archaeology of the site and what clues archaeologists uncovered about the 2,000-year-old Calusa Shell Mound. COST: \$5. Does not include Museum Admission. (Members FREE).

Cool Calusa Tools: Get hands-on with this interactive tours as you learn more about the tools and technologies of the Calusa. Perfect for families! COST: \$5. Does not include Museum Admission. (Members FREE).

Archaeology: Can you dig it? Learn what it takes to be an archaeologist! Handle real artifacts and discover how archaeologist study past cultures! Perfect for families! COST: \$5. Does not include Museum Admission. (Members FREE).

Latino History Tour: Expand your knowledge of Florida history by taking this tour to learn about the Latino fishing village, or rancho, which existed on the mound. COST: \$5. Does not include Museum Admission. (Members FREE).

Untold Stories Tour: From farmers to casino owners, scientists to developers, the Mound House has been home to a crew of characters who made history in their own way. COST: \$15 includes Museum Admission. (Members FREE).

Garden Tour: Discover the unique plants that make up the gardens of the Mound House and how the people have used them in the past and today. COST: \$5. Does not include Museum Admission. (Members FREE).
