On February 21, 2022 the Lee County Sheriff's Office responded to two separate vehicle burglaries on the south end of Fort Myers Beach. During one of the burglaries, a firearm as well as ammunition for that weapon were removed from a vehicle.

Deputies were able to obtain surveillance from the Outrigger beach resort, which showed the suspect, walking through the parking lot. Detectives with the West District Criminal Investigations Division were able to obtain more video which was sent out in hopes of identifying the suspect.

Deputy Joe Clark who has worked in West District for years was able to recognize the suspect and was able to provide the case detective with his name and pertinent information, which ultimately led to his arrest for both of the burglaries.

Tyree Duncan was ultimately charged with two separate burglaries to a vehicle, grand theft of a firearm, petit theft and is currently still incarcerated.

Thanks to Deputy Clark's vigilance, another felon was removed from Fort Myers Beach.
