**Boxcar Exhibit**

Stop by this month and see the Boxcar Exhibit which is on loan to the Library from Jack and F.E. Nortman and the Boxcar Foundation. It is being transported here from the Holocaust Museum and Cohen Education Center in Naples. The boxcar was manufactured in the Vorm Schumann Factory in Germany in 1919 and was in the service of the German Railway System until 1945 and from 1945 to 1969 was in the service of the Austrian State Railway. The boxcar was known by soldiers as "40 and 8" because it could carry 40 soldiers or 8 horses. It is also estimated that anywhere from 70-120 men, women and children were put in these boxcars at one time by the Nazis.
