Tuesday, February 10th, 10am in Room A.

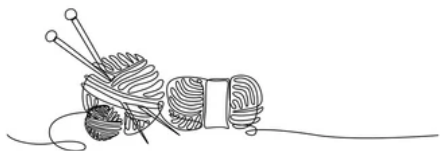

All are welcome. Whether you're managing your own stress or supporting others, this program offers helpful tools, insight, and encouragement for building resilience and well-being.

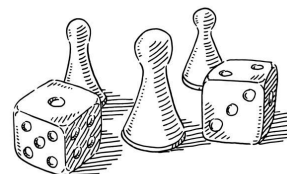
Mah Jongg- Planning Session

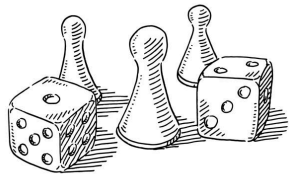
